- 1. A sharing of tuition costs for the first year after baptism/profession of faith with the church responsible for 35%, the Conference 35%, and the family 30%.
- 2. Registration fees and book costs are the responsibility of the family.
- 3. The request for scholarship is to be voted for approval by the School Board and forwarded to the Conference.
- 4. Students are eligible for this New Member Scholarship when they enroll in school within 12 months after family members become Seventh-day Adventists through baptism or profession of faith.
